

IMPACT REPORT 2017 IN REVIEW

Highlights

- Established the inaugural Bike Walk Macon Board of Directors and elected officers: Curtis Hertwig (President and Treasurer), Janis Haley (Vice President), and Alex Morrison (Secretary)
- Hired first Executive Director, Rachel Hollar
- Bike Walk Macon moves office to 338 Poplar St to provide a community space for bicycle and pedestrian advocacy, services, and education
- New Bike Walk Macon and Open Streets Macon websites created
- Hosted 28 fun and educational opportunities to learn about and/or experience biking and walking on Macon streets, possibly for the first time.
- 63 news stories about Bike Walk Macon initiatives or events
- 12 community presentations about Bike Walk Macon
- Awarded \$39,345 in grants to improve biking and walking in Macon-Bibb County
- Closed 1.5 miles of streets for Open Streets Macon (1500 people, 70+ volunteers, 32 activities, 5 neighborhoods)
- Received Emerging Partner award from NewTown Macon and Excellence Award from Center for Active Design for partnership with the Macon Connects project
- Partnered to host the Georgia Bike Summit for the first time ever in Macon
- 12 new bike racks installed in Downtown Macon through Macon Bike Biz program
- 2 new fix-it stations added Downtown by NewTown Macon
- Nearly 1 mile of bike lanes added on Montpelier Avenue
- Partnered with Centenary Community Ministries and Bike Tech Macon to create Re-Cycle Macon, a new earn-a-bike program to provide transportation for under-resourced individuals. Currently, 2 bicycles have been distributed.
- Macon-Bibb County Bike Committee formed by Macon-Bibb Planning & Zoning to create a county-wide bicycle network
